A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT 2 relating to increasing the punishment for the offense of fraudulent 3 or fictitious military record.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 32.54(c), Penal Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (c) An offense under this section is a Class \underline{B} [G] 8 misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 9 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 10 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 11 12 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 13 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 14 15 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 16

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
