1 and recommendations submitted by a recipient of information under 2 Subsection (a).

SECTION 2. Section 361.067, Health and Safety Code, 3 as amended by this Act, applies only to an application for the 4 5 issuance, amendment, or renewal of a permit pending before the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective 6 date of this Act. A permit issued, amended, or renewed before the 7 8 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the permit was issued, amended, or renewed, and the former law is 9 continued in effect for that purpose. 10

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
