A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to certain committees and programs to develop the wine
3	industry in this state through the Department of Agriculture.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 50B.002, Agriculture
6	Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 50B.002. WINE INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT [AND MARKETING]
8	ADVISORY COMMITTEE.
9	SECTION 2. Section 50B.002, Agriculture Code, is amended by
10	amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsections (b-1) and
11	(g) to read as follows:
12	(a) The commissioner shall appoint a wine industry
13	development [and marketing] advisory committee to:
14	(1) develop a long-term vision and marketable identity
15	for the wine industry in the state that take into consideration
16	future industry development, funding, research, educational
17	programming, risk management, and marketing; [and]
18	(2) assist the commissioner in establishing and
19	implementing the Texas Wine Marketing Assistance Program under
20	Chapter 110, Alcoholic Beverage Code <u>; and</u>
21	(3) assist and advise the commissioner in determining
22	the best and most productive and efficient expenditures of the wine
23	industry development fund.
24	(b) The committee consists of members appointed by the

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commissioner to [who] represent a diverse cross-section of the wine 1 2 industry, including representatives of: 3 (1)grape growers representing various regions of this 4 state; 5 wineries representing a variety of small, medium, (2) and large formats from the various regions of this state; 6 7 (3) [wholesalers; 8 [(4) package stores; 9 [(5) retailers; 10 [(6)] researchers or educators specializing in 11 viticulture or enology; (4) [(7)] consumers who are not affiliated with the 12 13 alcoholic beverage industry; (5) [(8)] the department; and 14 15 (6) [(9)] the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission. 16 (b-1) The members described by Subsections (b)(4) and (6) 17 are nonvoting members. 18 (g) Not later than September 1 of each year, the committee shall provide the commissioner with a written report containing: 19 20 (1) a summary of the committee's discussions, conclusions, and recommendations from the fiscal year preceding 21 that date; 22 (2) a proposed schedule and plan of action for the 23 fiscal year beginning on that date designed to implement and 24 further the objectives of this chapter and Chapter 110, Alcoholic 25 26 Beverage Code; (3) a proposed budget and prioritized spending plan 27

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for expenditures of the wine industry development fund; and 1 2 (4) other information requested by the commissioner or determined by a majority of the committee to be appropriate for 3 4 inclusion in the report. 5 SECTION 3. Chapter 50B, Agriculture Code, is amended by adding Section 50B.0025 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 50B.0025. ANNUAL PLAN AND BUDGET. Not later than November 1 of each year, the commissioner shall prepare for the 8 9 current fiscal year the schedule and plan of action and budget and prioritized spending plan described by Section 50B.002(g), 10 considering the recommendations of the committee under that section 11 and following them to the extent the commissioner considers 12 13 appropriate. SECTION 4. Section 50B.003(b), Agriculture Code, is amended 14 15 to read as follows: 16 (b) Except as provided by Sections 205.03(1), (m), and (n), Alcoholic Beverage Code, money [Money] in the account may be 17 appropriated only to the department and may be used only for the 18 purpose of: 19 20 (1)providing funding to public or private entities to conduct surveys, research, and other projects related to: 21 22 developing the Texas wine industry; (A) developing viticulture and enology-related 23 (B) 24 education programs; 25 (C) eliminating and eradicating [Pierce's disease, the glassy-winged sharpshooter, and other] diseases and 26 27 pests that negatively impact the production of grapes and wine in

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1 the United States; and
2 (D) developing technologies or practices that

3 could benefit the production of grapes and wine; and

4 (2) any administrative costs the department incurs in5 fulfilling the purposes described by Subdivision (1).

SECTION 5. Section 50B.0015, Agriculture Code, is repealed. 6 7 SECTION 6. On the effective date of this Act, the wine industry development and marketing advisory committee is 8 9 abolished. The commissioner of agriculture may appoint a person who previously served on that committee to the wine industry 10 development advisory committee established under Section 50B.002, 11 Agriculture Code, as amended by this Act. 12

13 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
