- 6 SECTION 1. Section 28.053, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsections (d), (e), and (f) and adding Subsection (d-1)
- to read as follows: 8

- 9 (d) In addition to any portion of a school award distributed
- to the teacher in accordance with a plan developed under Subsection 10
- (c), a [A] teacher participating in the program: 11
- 12 (1) may be awarded:
- 13 (A) $[\frac{1}{1}]$ subsidized teacher training, not to
- 14 exceed \$450 for each teacher, for a college advanced placement
- course or an international baccalaureate course; and 15
- 16 (B) $[\frac{(2)}{(2)}]$ a one-time award of \$250 for teaching a
- 17 college advanced placement an international course or
- baccalaureate course for the first time; and 18
- (2) shall be awarded a bonus in the amount specified by 19

- 1 [(3) a share of the teacher bonus pool, which shall be

- 4 (d-1) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, a
- 5 teacher shall be awarded a bonus under Subsection (d)(2) of \$50 for
- 6 each of the teacher's students who performs at the level specified
- 7 by Subsection (a)(2), not to exceed a total bonus of \$2,000 each
- 8 year. A teacher who provides instruction at a campus with an
- 9 unacceptable performance rating under Section 39.054 shall be
- 10 awarded a bonus of \$500 for the first student who performs at the
- 11 required level and \$50 for each additional student who performs at

- (e) To be eligible for an award under Subsection (d) or (f),

- 16 (f) From the school awards authorized under Subsection
- 17 (a)(2), \$50 [Fifty dollars] may be deposited in the teacher bonus
- 18 pool for each student enrolled in the school who [that] scores a
- 19 three or better on a college advanced placement test or four or
- 20 better on an international baccalaureate examination. Any money
- 21 placed in the teacher bonus pool shall be distributed by the
- 22 teacher's school to teachers participating in the program in shares
- 23 proportional to the number of courses taught.
