1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the disclosure of certain public information by a
 1-20 public school district.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
 1-23 amended by adding Section 552.030 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 552.030. REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION MADE TO SCHOOL
 1-25 DISTRICTS. (a) The control files of a database used by a school
 1-26 district to record financial information, or an analogous component
 1-27 that records the physical structure of the district's database, are
 1-28 public information subject to disclosure under this chapter.

1-29 (b) A school district shall cooperate with a requestor to
 1-30 provide information requested under this chapter in the most
 1-31 efficient and cost-effective manner practicable.

1-32 (c) This section does not require the disclosure of
 1-33 information for which an employee declines public access under
 1-34 Section 552.024 or of information made confidential under Section
 1-35 552.135 or 552.147.

1-36 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 1-37 to a request for public information made on or after the effective
 1-38 date of this Act. A request for public information made before the
 1-39 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
 1-40 date of the request, and that law is continued in effect for that
 1-41 purpose.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-43 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-44 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
