A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the disclosure of certain public information by a 1-19 public school district. 1-20 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 552, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 552.030 to read as follows: 1-22 1-23

Sec. 552.030. REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION MADE TO SCHOOL 1-24 1-25 DISTRICTS. (a) The control files of a database used by a school district to record financial information, or an analogous component 1-26 that records the physical structure of the district's database, are public information subject to disclosure under this chapter. (b) A school district shall cooperate with a requestor to 1-27 1-28

1-29 provide information requested under this chapter in the most efficient and cost-effective manner practicable. 1-30 1-31

(c) This section does not require the disclosure of information for which an employee declines public access under 1-32 1-33 Section 552.024 or of information made confidential under Section 1-34 552.135 or 5<u>52.147.</u> 1-35

1-36 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 1-37 to a request for public information made on or after the effective date of this Act. A request for public information made before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the 1-38 1-39 date of the request, and that law is continued in effect for that 1-40 1-41 purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-42 1-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-44 1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
