AN ACT

2 relating to the county courts at law in Bexar County.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Sections 25.0172(c), (c-1), (j), (v), and (w),

5 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:

6 (c) Any of the county courts at law may hear [The County

- 6 (c) Any of the county courts at law may hear [The County 7 Courts at Law Nos. 4, 6, 11, and 12 shall give preference to]
 8 criminal cases and appeals de novo from the municipal and justice 9 courts.
- 10 (c-1) The County <u>Courts</u> [Court] at Law <u>Nos. 7 and</u> [No.] 13 of 11 Bexar County, Texas, shall give preference to cases prosecuted 12 under:
- 13 (1) Section 22.01, Penal Code, in which the victim is a 14 person whose relationship to or association with the defendant is 15 described by Chapter 71, Family Code; and
- 16 (2) Section 25.07 or 25.072, Penal Code.
- (j) The judge of a county court at law shall be paid <u>as</u> 17 provided by Section 25.0005 [an annual salary in an amount not less 18 than \$25,000 and not more than the total annual salary, including 19 supplements, paid a district judge in the county]. 20 The 21 compensation shall be paid out of the county's general fund or 22 officers' salary fund. [The commissioners court shall consider the 23 financial condition of the county and the duties and needs of the county court at law judges in setting the salaries of the judges.] 2.4

- 1 Before raising a salary the commissioners court must publish notice
- 2 containing information of the salaries affected and the amount of
- 3 the proposed raise in a newspaper of general circulation in the
- 4 county. The commissioners court may raise the salaries of the
- 5 county court at law judges only after 10 days' notice and only at a
- 6 regular meeting of the commissioners court.
- 7 (v) Section $\underline{25.0006}$ [$\underline{25.0006(a)}$] does not apply to \underline{a} county
- 8 court at law in [County Courts at Law Nos. 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12,
- 9 13, 14, and 15 of] Bexar County. [Section 25.0006(b) does not apply
- 10 to County Courts at Law Nos. 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14,
- 11 and 15 of Bexar County.
- 12 (w) This section does not apply to the <u>statutory probate</u>
- 13 courts [County Court at Law No. 1 and Probate Court].
- SECTION 2. Sections 25.0172(a), (b), and (i), Government
- 15 Code, are repealed.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
