5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 28.0061 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 28.0061. READING EXCELLENCE TEAM PILOT PROGRAM.
8	(a) Using funds appropriated for that purpose, the commissioner
9	shall establish a reading excellence team pilot program in
10	accordance with this section.
11	(b) A school district is eligible to participate in the
12	pilot program if, as determined by the commissioner, the district
13	has low student performance on:
14	(1) a reading instrument administered in accordance
15	with Section 28.006(c); or
16	(2) a third grade reading assessment instrument
17	administered under Section 39.023(a).
18	(c) The pilot program must:
19	(1) establish reading excellence teams composed of

- 21 (2) allow an eligible school district to request the

- 1 (A) review with the district the results of the

- 13 SECTION 2. The commissioner of education shall establish
- 14 the pilot program under Section 28.0061, Education Code, as added
- 15 by this Act, not later than September 1, 2016.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
