(a) Using funds appropriated for that purpose, the commissioner 8 shall establish a reading excellence team pilot program in 9 10 accordance with this section. (b) A school district is eligible to participate in the 11 12 pilot program if, as determined by the commissioner, the district has low student performance on: 13 14 (1) a reading instrument administered in accordance with Section 28.006(c); or 15 (2) a third grade reading assessment instrument 16 administered under Section 39.023(a). 17 (c) The pilot program must: 18 19 (1) establish reading excellence teams composed of reading instruction specialists; 20 (2) allow an eligible school district to request the 21 22 assistance of a reading excellence team; and

(3) provide a reading excellence team to a requesting

eligible school district to:

- 1 (A) review with the district the results of the
- 2 assessments described under Subsection (b) to determine campuses
- 3 and classrooms for kindergarten through third grade with the
- 4 greatest need of assistance; and
- 5 (B) work with teachers on campuses and in
- 6 classrooms identified under Paragraph (A) to provide training
- 7 necessary to improve student reading outcomes.
- 8 <u>(d) The commissioner shall adopt rules to administer this</u>
- 9 section, including rules establishing qualifications and criteria
- 10 for selecting reading instruction specialists for a reading
- 11 <u>excellence team.</u>
- 12 (e) This section expires September 1, 2021.
- 13 SECTION 2. The commissioner of education shall establish
- 14 the pilot program under Section 28.0061, Education Code, as added
- 15 by this Act, not later than September 1, 2016.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
