9	meaning assigned by Section 101.033, Family Code.
10	(b) As authorized by 7 U.S.C. Section 2015(n), a person may
11	not receive supplemental nutrition assistance benefits as a member
12	of any household during any month in which the person is delinquent
13	in making a court-ordered child support payment.
14	(c) The restriction in Subsection (b) does not apply if a
15	court has allowed the person to delay payment or if the person is
16	complying with a payment plan approved by a court or the Title IV-D
17	agency.
18	(d) The department and the Title IV-D agency shall jointly
19	enforce this section.
20	SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
21	a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
22	federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
23	the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
24	authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
