A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to permissible locations of open-enrollment charter
- 3 schools created by certain institutions of higher education.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.152, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 12.152. AUTHORIZATION. (a) In accordance with this
- 8 subchapter and Subchapter D, the commissioner may grant a charter
- 9 on the application of:
- 10 (1) a public senior college or university for an
- 11 open-enrollment charter school to operate on the campus of the
- 12 public senior college or university or , subject to Subsection (b) ,
- 13 at another location in any county in this state [in the same county
- 14 in which the campus of the public senior college or university is
- 15 located]; or
- 16 (2) a public junior college for an open-enrollment
- 17 charter school to operate on the campus of the public junior college
- 18 or in the same county in which the campus of the public junior
- 19 college is located.
- 20 (b) In evaluating an application submitted under Subsection
- 21 (a)(1) for a charter to operate an open-enrollment charter school
- 22 in a county other than the county in which the campus of the
- 23 applicant is located, the commissioner shall consider:
- 24 (1) the locations of existing open-enrollment charter

- 1 schools, as appropriate, to avoid duplication of services in the
- 2 area in which the applicant proposes to operate the school; and
- 3 (2) the need of the community in the area in which the
- 4 applicant proposes to operate the school to have an additional
- 5 open-enrollment charter school.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 12.152, Education Code, as amended by
- 7 this Act:
- 8 (1) applies to an application for a new charter
- 9 pending on or submitted on or after the effective date of this Act;
- 10 and
- 11 (2) authorizes a public senior college or university
- 12 that holds a charter granted before the effective date of this Act
- 13 to operate a charter school at a location in any county of this
- 14 state, provided that if the college or university seeks to operate
- 15 an additional campus and the commissioner's approval of the
- 16 expansion is required under Chapter 12, Education Code, the college
- 17 or university must obtain the commissioner's approval.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
