Section 161.041(c), Agriculture Code, is amended 6 to read as follows: 7 8 (c) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly fails to handle, in accordance with rules adopted by the 9 10 commission, livestock, exotic livestock, domestic fowl, or exotic 11 fowl: infected with a disease listed in Subsection (a); 12 (1)13 (2) exposed, as defined by commission rule, to a disease listed in Subsection (a) if the commission has notified the 14 15 person that the animal was exposed to the disease; or (3) subject to a testing requirement due to a risk of 16 exposure, as defined by commission rule, to a specific disease if 17 the commission has notified the person of the testing requirement. 18 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 20 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 21 22 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 23 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 24

effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
before that date.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
