18	(9) limited benefit.
19	SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2016, the commissioner
20	of insurance shall adopt any rules necessary to implement Section
21	1201.104, Insurance Code, as amended by this Act.
22	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
