- 8 n 9 in Harris County of eminent domain proceedings, both statutory and inverse, if the amount in controversy in a statutory proceeding 10 does not exceed the amount provided by Section 25.0003(c) in civil 11 cases. Notwithstanding Section 21.013, Property Code, a party 12 13 initiating a condemnation proceeding in Harris County may file a petition with the district clerk when the amount in controversy 14 exceeds the amount provided by Section 25.0003(c). The amount in 15 controversy is the amount of the bona fide offer made by the entity 16 with eminent domain authority to acquire the property from the 17 property owner voluntarily [regardless of the amount in 18 controversy]. 19
- 20 <u>(d)</u> In addition to other jurisdiction provided by law, a 21 county civil court at law has jurisdiction to:
- 22 (1) decide the issue of title to real or personal 23 property;
- 24 (2) hear a suit to recover damages for slander or

- 1 defamation of character;
- 2 (3) hear a suit for the enforcement of a lien on real
- 3 property;
- 4 (4) hear a suit for the forfeiture of a corporate
- 5 charter;
- 6 (5) hear a suit for the trial of the right to property
- 7 valued at \$200 or more that has been levied on under a writ of
- 8 execution, sequestration, or attachment; and
- 9 (6) hear a suit for the recovery of real property.
- 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to an eminent domain proceeding for which a petition is filed on or
- 12 after the effective date of this Act. An eminent domain proceeding
- 13 for which a petition is filed before the effective date of this Act
- 14 is governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and
- 15 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
