A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to a requirement that the General Land Office conduct a 2 3 study regarding the use of wind or solar power to desalinate 4 brackish groundwater. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act: 6 (1) "Development board" 7 the Texas means Water 8 Development Board. (2) "Land office" means the General Land Office. 9 SECTION 2. STUDY. (a) The land office in consultation 10 with the development board shall conduct a study regarding the use 11 12 of wind or solar power to desalinate brackish groundwater on real 13 property owned by the state. 14 The land office and the development board may request (b) 15 data from any state agency in conducting the study. An agency receiving a request under this subsection shall provide the 16 requested data. 17 The land office may coordinate with a research division 18 (C) of a university in conducting the study. 19 SECTION 3. REPORT. (a) Not later than December 31, 2016, 20 the land office shall report the results of the study conducted 21 22 under this Act to the governor and the legislature. 23 The report described by this section may not disclose (b)

2 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect 3 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members 4 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas 5 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for 6 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
