- 11 (d) If assistance is provided by a person of the voter's
- 12 choice, the person shall provide a photo identification to an
- 13 election officer and the officer shall enter the person's name and
- 14 address on the poll list beside the voter's name.
- 15 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 64, Election Code, is
- 16 amended by adding Section 64.0325 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 64.0325. UNSOLICITED OFFER OF ASSISTANCE. (a) A
- 18 person who is not an election officer commits an offense if:
- 19 (1) the person offers to assist a voter under Section
- 20 **64.032**; and
- 21 (2) before developing the intent to make the offer of
- 22 assistance, the voter was not known to the person.
- 23 (b) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
