1-24 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-25 AN ACT

1-26 relating to supplemental compensation paid to certain county
 1-27 judges.

1-28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-29 SECTION 1. Section 26.006(a), Government Code, is amended
 1-30 to read as follows:

1-31 (a) A county judge is entitled to an annual salary
 1-32 supplement from the state in an amount equal to 18 percent of the
 1-33 annual compensation provided for a district judge in the General
 1-34 Appropriations Act [~~of \$15,000~~] if at least 40 percent of the
 1-35 functions that the judge performs are judicial functions.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
