4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 84, Election Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 84.038 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 84.038. CANCELLATION EFFECTIVE FOR SINGLE ELECTION FOR
8	CERTAIN VOTERS. The cancellation of an application for a ballot to
9	be voted by mail under Section 84.032(c), (d), or (e) does not
10	cancel the application with respect to a subsequent election to
11	which the same application applies under Section 86.0015(b).
12	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
13	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
14	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
15	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
16	Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
