A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to a study by the General Land Office regarding the
- 3 feasibility of creating a mechanism by which a governmental entity
- 4 could acquire small parcels of real property in an area and convey
- 5 them to a developer in order to ensure the property is developed in
- 6 compliance with model subdivision rules.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. (a) The General Land Office shall conduct a
- 9 study of the feasibility of establishing a mechanism by which a
- 10 governmental entity could:
- 11 (1) acquire contiguous small parcels of real property
- 12 that have nominal value;
- 13 (2) combine the properties in a manner that makes the
- 14 properties marketable for development; and
- 15 (3) convey the properties to a developer for
- 16 development of the property in a manner that complies with
- 17 standards prescribed by model subdivision rules adopted under
- 18 Section 16.343, Water Code.
- 19 (b) The study conducted under this section must:
- 20 (1) establish methods for identifying property
- 21 suitable for acquisition;
- 22 (2) establish methods for identifying owners of
- 23 property considered suitable for acquisition;
- 24 (3) identify appropriate methods of acquiring,

- 1 holding title to, and conveying the property and include an
- 2 analysis of the appropriateness of acquiring the property;
- 3 (4) identify appropriate methods of compensating the
- 4 owners of the property acquired;
- 5 (5) identify any appropriate land use or development
- 6 requirements or restrictions for the property; and
- 7 (6) identify any legislative action necessary to
- 8 facilitate the establishment of a mechanism described by this
- 9 section.
- 10 (c) Not later than December 1, 2016, the General Land Office
- 11 shall provide to the legislature a report containing the results of
- 12 the study conducted under this section.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
