## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the eligibility for indigent status for purposes of the
- 3 driver responsibility program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 708.158(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The department shall waive all surcharges assessed
- 8 under this chapter for a person who is indigent. For the purposes
- 9 of this section, a person is considered to be indigent if the
- 10 person:

- 11 (1) was determined to be indigent for the purpose of
- 12 appointing counsel under Article 26.04, Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 13 for the offense that is the basis for the surcharge, and the court
- 14 did not make a subsequent finding that the person had the ability to
- 15 pay, wholly or partly, the cost of the appointed counsel; or
- 16 (2) provides the evidence described by Subsection (b)
- 17 to the court.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 19 708.158, Transportation Code, applies to a surcharge pending on the
- 20 effective date of this Act, regardless of when the surcharge was
- 21 assessed.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
