A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the issuance of certain permits for the movement of oversize or overweight vehicles. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 623.301, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 623.301. OPTIONAL PROCEDURE. This subchapter provides 7 an optional procedure for the issuance of a permit by the Port of 8 Corpus Christi Authority for the movement of oversize or overweight 9 vehicles carrying cargo on a state highway special freight corridor 10 11 located in San Patricio County or Nueces County. SECTION 2. Section 623.302(2), Transportation Code, 12 is amended to read as follows: 13 14 (2) "Special freight corridor" means a highway built by this state specifically for the movement of oversize or 15 16 overweight vehicles carrying cargo in San Patricio County or Nueces <u>County</u> to and from the port authority's: 17 18 (A) La Quinta terminal; or (B) Joe Fulton International Trade Corridor. 19 20 SECTION 3. Section 623.303, Transportation Code, is amended 21 to read as follows: 22 Sec. 623.303. ISSUANCE OF PERMITS. The Texas 23 Transportation Commission may authorize the port authority to issue permits for the movement of oversize or overweight vehicles 24

S.B. No. 1059 carrying cargo on state highway special freight corridors located 1 in San Patricio County or Nueces County. The port authority may 2 issue a permit under this subchapter only if the cargo being 3 transported weighs 125,000 pounds or less. 4 5 SECTION 4. Section 623.306(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 A permit issued under this subchapter must include: (a) 8 (1)the name of the applicant; (2) the date of issuance; 9 10 (3) the signature of the manager of transportation of the port authority; 11 of statement 12 (4) а the kind of carqo being transported, the maximum weight and dimensions of the equipment, 13 14 and the kind and weight of each commodity to be transported; 15 (5) a statement of any condition on which the permit is 16 issued; 17 (6) a statement that the cargo may only be transported to and from the port authority's: 18 (A) La Quinta terminal in San Patricio County 19 using a state highway special freight corridor in San Patricio 20 21 County; or (B) Joe Fulton International Trade Corridor in 22 Nueces County using a state highway special freight corridor in 23 Nueces County; and 24 (7) the location where the cargo was loaded. 25 26 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
