- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 4102, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 4102.164 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 4102.164. SOLICITATION FOR OR REFERRAL TO ATTORNEY.
- 8 (a) A license holder may not directly or indirectly solicit
- 9 employment for an attorney in connection with a claim for loss or
- 10 damage that the license holder negotiates, investigates, or adjusts
- 11 on behalf of an insured.
- 12 (b) A license holder, in exchange for referring a claim for
- 13 loss or damage under an insurance policy covering real or personal
- 14 property, or an insured or other person in connection with the
- 15 claim, to an attorney, may not:
- 16 (1) receive a fee or other compensation from the
- 17 attorney; or
- 18 (2) split a fee or other compensation with the
- 19 <u>attorney</u>.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a solicitation or
- 21 referral that occurs on or after September 1, 2015. A solicitation
- 22 or referral that occurs before September 1, 2015, is governed by the
- 23 law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- 24 and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
