[(3) a final value for each school district computed on the effect of the reduction of the limitation on tax increases to reflect any reduction in the school district tax rate as provided by Section 11.26(a-1), (a-2), or (a-3), Tax Code, as applicable].

6 SECTION 2. Section 403.302(k), Government Code, is 7 repealed.

8 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 9 to a certification made by the comptroller of public accounts of the 10 adjusted taxable value for a school district to the commissioner of 11 education on or after the effective date of this Act.

12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016.
