## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the eligibility of a Professional Rodeo Cowboys 3 Association Finals Event for funding from the Major Events trust 4 fund.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Sections 5A(a)(4) and (5), Chapter 1507 (S.B. 7 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article 8 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), are amended to read as 9 follows:

"Event" means a Super Bowl, a National Collegiate 10 (4)Athletic Association Final Four tournament game, the National 11 12 Basketball Association All-Star Game, the X Games, the National Hockey League All-Star Game, the Major League Baseball All-Star 13 Game, a game of the National Collegiate Athletic Association Bowl 14 15 Championship Series or its successor or a National Collegiate Athletic Association Division I Football Bowl Subdivision 16 17 postseason playoff or championship game, a World Cup Soccer game, the World Games, a Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association Finals 18 Event, a national collegiate championship of an amateur sport 19 sanctioned by the national governing body of the sport that is 20 recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, an Olympic 21 22 activity, including a Junior or Senior activity, training program, or feeder program sanctioned by the United States Olympic 23 24 Committee's Community Olympic Development Program, a mixed martial

arts championship, the Breeders' Cup World Championships, a Formula 1 2 One automobile race, the Academy of Country Music Awards, the National Cutting Horse Association Triple Crown, 3 a national 4 political convention of the Republican National Committee or the Democratic National Committee, or the largest event held each year 5 at a sports entertainment venue in this state with a permanent 6 7 seating capacity, including grandstand and premium seating, of not less than 125,000. The term includes any activities related to or 8 associated with an event. 9

## (5) "Site selection organization" means:

11 (A) the National Football League, the National 12 Collegiate Athletic Association, the National Basketball 13 Association, the National Hockey League, Major League Baseball, the Federation Internationale de Football Association (FIFA), the 14 International World Games Association, the Professional Rodeo 15 Cowboys Association, or the United States Olympic Committee; 16

(B) the national governing body of a sport that
is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, the National
Thoroughbred Racing Association, Formula One Management Limited,
or the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile;

(C) the Academy of Country Music;

(D) the National Cutting Horse Association; or

(E) the Republican National Committee or the24 Democratic National Committee.

25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
