- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 417.0081, Government
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 417.0081. INSPECTION OF [CERTAIN] STATE-OWNED OR
- 8 STATE-LEASED BUILDINGS.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 417.0081(a), Government Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The state fire marshal, at the commissioner's
- 12 direction, shall periodically inspect public buildings under the
- 13 charge and control of <u>a state agency</u> [the Texas Facilities
- 14 Commission] and buildings leased for the use of a state agency [by
- 15 the Texas Facilities Commission].
- SECTION 3. Section 417.0082, Government Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 417.0082. PROTECTION OF [CERTAIN] STATE-OWNED OR
- 19 STATE-LEASED BUILDINGS AGAINST FIRE HAZARDS; AUTHORITY OF STATE
- 20 FIRE MARSHAL. (a) The state fire marshal, under the direction of
- 21 the commissioner, shall take any action necessary to protect a
- 22 public building under the charge and control of a state agency [the
- 23 Texas Facilities Commission, and the building's occupants, and the
- 24 occupants of a building leased for the use of a state agency [by the

- 1 Texas Facilities Commission], against an existing or threatened
- 2 fire hazard. The state fire marshal [and the Texas Facilities
- 3 Commission] shall include the State Office of Risk Management and
- 4 each state agency occupying or managing an affected building in all
- 5 communication concerning fire hazards.
- 6 (b) The commissioner[, the Texas Facilities Commission,]
- 7 and the <u>State Office of Risk Management</u> [risk management board]
- 8 shall make and each adopt [by rule] a memorandum of understanding
- 9 that coordinates the agency's duties under this section.
- 10 (c) The state fire marshal is the authority having
- 11 jurisdiction over a state-owned building for purposes of fire
- 12 safety.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
