- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 617, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 617.0021 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 617.0021. EXCLUSIVE CONSULTATION PROHIBITED. (a) An
- 8 official of this state or of a political subdivision of this state
- 9 may not enter into a consultation agreement in which one or more
- 10 groups are designated as an agent for the purposes of consulting
- 11 with or representing public employees on employment issues,
- 12 including wages, benefits, and other conditions of employment.
- 13 (b) This state or a political subdivision of this state may
- 14 not prohibit an employee or a group of employees from seeking
- 15 advice, counsel, or the exchange of information on employment
- 16 matters, including wages, benefits, employment policies, and other
- 17 conditions of employment.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
