AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain purchasing methods by state agencies and local
 3 governments.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2157.068, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (e-1) and (j) to read as follows:
- 7 (e-1) A state agency shall purchase an automated
- 8 information system from the published list using competitive
- 9 pricing requests for purchases of more than \$50,000 including when
- 10 purchasing an item under Subsection (e).
- 11 (j) The department shall, in cooperation with state
- 12 agencies, monitor and verify the purchase transaction reports
- 13 <u>submitted by vendors reflecting monthly sales made under Subsection</u>
- 14 (e) to ensure the accuracy of the reports.
- SECTION 2. Section 2155.504(a), Government Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:

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- 17 (a) A state agency or local government may purchase goods or
- 18 services directly from a vendor under a contract listed on a
- 19 schedule developed under this subchapter. [A purchase authorized
- 20 by this section satisfies any requirement of state law relating to
- 21 competitive bids or proposals and satisfies any applicable
- 22 requirements of Chapter 2157.
- 23 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only in
- 24 relation to a contract:

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- 1 (1) for which a state agency first advertises or
- 2 otherwise solicits bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications on or
- 3 after the effective date of this Act;
- 4 (2) that is extended or modified on or after the
- 5 effective date of this Act; or
- 6 (3) for which a change order is submitted on or after
- 7 the effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
