A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the establishment of a transfer associate degree
- 3 program at each public junior college.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 130.0104 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 130.0104. TRANSFER ASSOCIATE DEGREE PROGRAM. (a) The
- 8 governing board of each public junior college district shall
- 9 <u>establish a transfer associate degree program at each junior</u>
- 10 college in the district.
- 11 (b) A transfer associate degree program established at a
- 12 junior college under this section must require a student to
- 13 <u>successfully complete:</u>
- 14 (1) the junior college's core curriculum adopted under
- 15 Section 61.822(b); and
- 16 (2) the courses selected by the student in the
- 17 student's degree plan completed under Subsection (c).
- (c) Notwithstanding Section 51.9685, before the beginning
- 19 of the regular semester or term immediately following the semester
- 20 or term in which a student successfully completes a cumulative
- 21 total of 30 or more semester credit hours for coursework in a
- 22 transfer associate degree program established under this section,
- 23 the student must meet with an academic advisor to complete a degree
- 24 plan, as defined by Section 51.9685(a)(1), that:

- 1 (1) accounts for all remaining credit hours required
- 2 for the completion of the degree program; and
- 3 <u>(2) emphasizes:</u>
- 4 (A) the student's transition to a particular
- 5 four-year college or university that the student chooses; and
- 6 (B) preparations for the student's intended
- 7 <u>field of study or major at the four-year college or university.</u>
- 8 (d) The coordinating board shall adopt rules as necessary
- 9 for the administration of this section, including rules ensuring
- 10 <u>that:</u>
- 11 (1) a transfer associate degree program is established
- 12 at each public junior college; and
- 13 (2) the common application form adopted under Section
- 14 51.762 contains a description of transfer associate degree programs
- 15 established under this section.
- 16 SECTION 2. (a) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating
- 17 Board shall adopt the rules required by Section 130.0104, Education
- 18 Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after the
- 19 effective date of this Act. For that purpose, the coordinating
- 20 board may adopt the initial rules in the manner provided by law for
- 21 emergency rules.
- (b) The governing board of each public junior college
- 23 district shall offer a transfer associate degree program at each
- 24 junior college in the district as required by Section 130.0104,
- 25 Education Code, as added by this Act, beginning with the 2016 fall
- 26 semester.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
