4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 54.015, Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 54.015. BILLING AND NOTIFICATION FOR TUITION AND FEES.
8	(a) In this section, "general academic teaching institution" and
9	"public state college" have the meanings assigned by Section
10	<u>61.003.</u>
11	(b) A general academic teaching institution other than a
12	public state college shall provide to each student enrolled at the
13	institution for a semester or term a tuition and fee bill or other
14	billing statement for that semester or term. The bill or statement
15	<u>must:</u>
16	(1) state the total amount of all tuition and fees
17	charged to the student for the semester or term; and
18	(2) include an itemized list of:
19	(A) the tuition and fees charged to the student
20	by the institution for each course in which the student is enrolled
21	for that semester or term; and
22	(B) each other fee charged to the student by the
23	institution for that semester or term.
24	<u>(c)</u> For billing and catalogue purposes, each governing

S.B. No. 1207 1 board shall accumulate all the tuition that it charges under this 2 chapter into one tuition charge.

3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies 4 beginning with the 2015 fall semester.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
