If a school district maintains a 19 generally accessible Internet website, the district shall provide 20 on its website a link to the application. 21 SECTION 2. Section 303.005(a), Labor Code, is amended to 22 23 read as follows:

technical college for customized training and assessment from the 1 college through a grant issued to the college under the skills 2 3 development fund program established under this chapter and for a grant under the Texas Enterprise Fund program established under 4 5 Subchapter E, Chapter 481, Government Code, unless the employer and the college file an application for concurrent participation in 6 both programs using a single application under Section 481.0785, 7 Government Code [that complies with any rules adopted by the Texas 8 9 Workforce Commission on concurrent participation].

SECTION 3. Section 313.031, Tax Code, is amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

12 (b-1) For purposes of this chapter, including Section 13 <u>313.025(a)</u>, an application made using a single application under 14 <u>Section 481.0785</u>, Government Code, is considered to be an 15 <u>application on a form prescribed by the comptroller</u>.
