A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to public school class size limits.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 25.112(a) and (d), Education Code, are
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) Except as otherwise authorized by this section, a school
- 7 district may not enroll <u>at a campus</u> more than <u>a campus-wide average</u>
- 8 <u>at each grade level of</u> 22 students <u>in a class</u> in [a] kindergarten,
- 9 first, second, third, and [or] fourth grade [class]. That
- 10 limitation does not apply during:
- 11 (1) any 12-week period of the school year selected by
- 12 the district, in the case of a district whose average daily
- 13 attendance is adjusted under Section 42.005(c); or
- 14 (2) the last 12 weeks of any school year in the case of
- 15 any other district.
- 16 (d) On application of a school district, the commissioner
- 17 may except the district from the limit in Subsection (a) for the
- 18 school year if the commissioner finds the limit works an undue
- 19 hardship on the district. An exception expires at the end of the
- 20 school year for which it is granted.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 25.113(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 (a) A campus or district that is granted an exception under
- 24 Section 25.112(d) from class size limits shall provide written

- 1 notice of the exception to the parent of or person standing in
- 2 parental relation to each student affected by the exception. The
- 3 notice must be in conspicuous bold or underlined print and:
- 4 (1) specify the grade level [class] for which an
- 5 exception from the limit imposed by Section 25.112(a) was granted;
- 6 (2) state the number of children in <u>each</u> [the] class <u>at</u>
- 7 the grade level for which the exception was granted; and
- 8 (3) be included in a regular mailing or other
- 9 communication from the campus or district, such as information sent
- 10 home with students.
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 12 school year.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
