3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 462.201, Insurance Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:

- 6 Sec. 462.201. COVERED CLAIMS IN GENERAL. A claim is a
- 7 covered claim if:
- 8 (1) the claim is an unpaid claim;
- 9 (2) the claim is made under an insurance policy to 10 which this chapter applies that is:
- 11 (A) issued by an insurer authorized to engage in
- 12 business in this state; or
- 13 (B) assumed by an insurer authorized to engage in
- 14 business in this state that issues an assumption certificate to the
- 15 insured;
- 16 (3) the claim arises out of the policy and is within
- 17 the coverage and applicable limits of the policy;
- 18 (4) the insurer that issued the policy or assumed the
- 19 policy under an assumption certificate issued to the insured is an
- 20 impaired insurer; and
- 21 (5) the claim:
- (A) is made by a liability claimant or insured
- 23 who is a resident of this state at the time of the insured event;

- 1 (B) is a first-party claim for damage to property
- 2 that is permanently located in this state; or
- 3 (C) is made by a person holding a valid
- 4 assignment of a claim described by Paragraph (A) or (B) or Section
- 5 462.202.
- 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 7 to a claim under Chapter 462, Insurance Code, in relation to an
- 8 insurer that is designated as an impaired insurer on or after the
- 9 effective date of this Act. A claim under Chapter 462, Insurance
- 10 Code, in relation to an insurer that is designated as an impaired
- 11 insurer before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 12 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 13 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
