Each of these individuals is considered to be operating at the pain management clinic. 16 SECTION 2. Section 168.201(d), Occupations Code, is amended 17 to read as follows: 18 A person who owns or operates a pain management clinic 19 (d) is engaged in the practice of medicine. This shall include, but is 20 not limited to, all supervision and delegation activities related 21
