A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a study on the implementation of a traffic light 3 synchronization program. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. 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1 (d) Not later than October 1, 2016, the Texas Department of 2 Transportation shall issue a report on the study required under 3 this section to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker 4 of the house of representatives, and the appropriate standing 5 committees of the house of representatives and the senate.

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(e) This Act expires September 1, 2017.

7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
