- 4 SECTION 1. Section 209.0041(h), Property Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (h) Except as provided by this subsection, a declaration may
- 7 be amended only by a vote of 60 = 60 [67] percent of the total votes cast
- 8 by members of [allocated to property owners in] the property
- 9 owners' association, in addition to any governmental approval
- 10 required by law. If the declaration contains a lower threshold
- 11 [percentage], the threshold [percentage] in the declaration
- 12 controls.
- SECTION 2. Section 209.0056(a), Property Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (a) Not later than the 30th $[\frac{10th}{}]$ day or earlier than the
- 16 60th day before the date of an election or vote, a property owners'
- 17 association shall give written notice of the election or vote to:
- 18 (1) each owner of property in the property owners'
- 19 association, for purposes of an association-wide election or vote;

- 21 (2) each owner of property in the property owners'
- 22 association entitled under the dedicatory instruments to vote in a
- 23 particular representative election, for purposes of a vote that
- 24 involves election of representatives of the association who are

- 1 vested under the dedicatory instruments of the property owners'
- 2 association with the authority to elect or appoint board members of
- 3 the property owners' association.
- 4 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 5 to an election or vote held on or after November 1, 2015. An
- 6 election or vote held before November 1, 2015, is governed by the
- 7 law applicable to the election or vote immediately before the
- 8 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 9 that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
