4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 552.305(d), Government Code, is amended

- 7 (d) If release of a person's proprietary information may be 8 subject to exception under Section 552.101, 552.110, or 552.113, 9 [or 552.131,] the governmental body that requests an attorney 10 general decision under Section 552.301 shall make a good faith
- 11 attempt to notify that person of the request for the attorney
- 12 general decision. Notice under this subsection must:
- 13 (1) be in writing and sent within a reasonable time not 14 later than the 10th business day after the date the governmental
- 15 body receives the request for the information; and
- 16 (2) include:

to read as follows:

- 17 (A) a copy of the written request for the 18 information, if any, received by the governmental body; and
- 19 (B) a statement, in the form prescribed by the
- 20 attorney general, that the person is entitled to submit in writing
- 21 to the attorney general within a reasonable time not later than the
- 22 10th business day after the date the person receives the notice:
- (i) each reason the person has as to why the
- 24 information should be withheld; and

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- 1 (ii) a letter, memorandum, or brief in
- 2 support of that reason.
- 3 SECTION 2. Sections 551.087 and 552.131, Government Code,
- 4 are repealed.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
