- 15 employees do not sell hearing instruments;
- 16 (2) a physician licensed by the Texas Medical Board;
- 17 (3) a person with a master's degree or doctorate in
- 18 audiology from an accredited college or university who does not
- 19 sell hearing instruments, to the extent the person engages in the
- 20 measurement of human hearing by the use of an audiometer or by any
- 21 other means to make selections and adaptations of or
