A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to limiting certain state-required assessment instruments administered to public school students in certain grades to 3 assessments required by federal law. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.023(a), Education Code, as effective 6 until on or before September 1, 2015, is amended to read as follows: 7 (a) The agency shall adopt or develop appropriate 8 criterion-referenced assessment instruments designed to assess 9 essential knowledge and skills in subjects for which assessment is 10 required by federal law [reading, writing, mathematics, social 11 studies, and science]. Except as provided by Subsection (a-2), all 12 students, other than students assessed under Subsection (b) or (1) 13 14 or exempted under Section 39.027, shall be assessed in [+ [(1) mathematics, annually in grades three through 15 seven without the aid of technology and in grade eight with the aid 16 of technology on any assessment instrument that includes algebra; 17 18 [(2) reading, annually in grades three through eight; [(3) writing, including spelling and grammar, in 19 grades four and seven; 20 21 [(4) social studies, in grade eight; 22 [(5) science, in grades five and eight; and [(6)] any [other] subject and grade required by 23 24 federal law.

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SECTION 2. Section 39.023(a), Education Code, as effective 1 2 on or before September 1, 2015, is amended to read as follows: 3 (a) The agency shall adopt or develop appropriate criterion-referenced assessment instruments designed to assess 4 5 essential knowledge and skills in subjects for which assessment is required by federal law [reading, writing, mathematics, social 6 7 studies, and science]. Except as provided by Subsection (a-2), all 8 students, other than students assessed under Subsection (b) or (1) or exempted under Section 39.027, shall be assessed in any subject 9 10 and grade required by federal law [+ [(1) mathematics, in grades three and five without the 11 aid of technology and in grade eight with the aid of technology on

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12 aid of technology and in grade eight with the aid of technology on 13 any assessment instrument that includes algebra;

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[(2) reading, in grades three, five, and eight;

15 [(3) writing, including spelling and grammar, in 16 grades four and seven;

17 [(4) social studies, in grade eight; and

[(5) science, in grades five and eight].

SECTION 3. Section 39.023(a), Education Code, as effective September 1, 2017, is amended to read as follows:

21 (a) The agency shall adopt or develop appropriate criterion-referenced assessment instruments designed to assess 22 essential knowledge and skills in subjects for which assessment is 23 24 required by federal law [reading, writing, mathematics, social studies, and science]. Except as provided by Subsection (a-2), all 25 26 students, other than students assessed under Subsection (b) or (1) or exempted under Section 39.027, shall be assessed in [+ 27

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[(1) mathematics, annually in grades three through 1 seven without the aid of technology and in grade eight with the aid 2 of technology on any assessment instrument that includes algebra; 3 [(2) reading, annually in grades three through eight; 4 [(3) writing, including spelling and grammar, in 5 6 grades four and seven; 7 [(4) social studies, in grade eight; [(5) science, in grades five and eight; and 8 9 [(6)] any [other] subject and grade required by federal law. 10 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016 11 school year. 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 14 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2015. 17

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
