3 <u>(a-1) As part of the mental health intervention program for</u>
4 <u>veterans, the department shall develop a women veterans mental</u>
5 health initiative.

6 (b) The department shall solicit and ensure that 7 specialized training is provided to persons who are peers and who 8 want to provide peer-to-peer counseling or other peer-to-peer 9 services under the program.

10 (c) The executive commissioner may adopt rules necessary to 11 implement this subchapter.

12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
