1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to grants to local governmental entities from the Texas
 1-20 Military Preparedness Commission.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 436.202, Government Code, is amended by
 1-23 amending Subsections (a), (b), and (c) and adding Subsection (e) to
 1-24 read as follows:

1-25 (a) From money appropriated for this purpose, the
 1-26 commission may make a grant to an eligible local governmental
 1-27 entity to:

1-28 (1) enable the entity to match money or meet an
 1-29 investment requirement necessary to receive federal assistance
 1-30 provided to the local governmental entity for responding to or
 1-31 recovering from an event described by Section 436.201(b);

1-32 (2) match the entity's contribution for a purpose
 1-33 described by Section 436.203 at a closed or realigned defense
 1-34 facility; ~~or~~

1-35 (3) construct infrastructure and other projects
 1-36 necessary to accommodate a new or expanded military mission at a
 1-37 military base or to reduce the impact of an action of the United
 1-38 States Department of Defense that will negatively impact a defense
 1-39 facility located in or near the entity; or

1-40 (4) construct affordable single family, multifamily,
 1-41 and veteran's supportive housing financed under the low income
 1-42 housing tax credit program under Subchapter DD, Chapter 2306.

1-43 (b) The commission may not make a grant for an amount less
 1-44 than \$50,000 or an amount more than the lesser of:

1-45 (1) 50 percent of the amount of matching money or
 1-46 investment that the local governmental entity is required to
 1-47 provide, subject to Subsection (c);

1-48 (2) 50 percent of the local governmental entity's
 1-49 investment for purposes described by Section 436.203 if federal
 1-50 assistance is unavailable; or

1-51 (3) \$5 [~~\$2~~] million.

1-52 (c) If the local governmental entity demonstrates to the
 1-53 commission that, because of a limited budget, the entity lacks the
 1-54 resources necessary to provide 50 percent of the amount of matching
 1-55 money or investment that the entity is required to provide, the
 1-56 commission may make a grant in an amount of not more than 80 percent
 1-57 of the amount of that matching money or investment requirement but
 1-58 may not make a grant in an amount that exceeds \$5 [~~\$2~~] million.

1-59 (e) The commission may make a grant to an eligible local
 1-60 governmental entity for a project described by Subsection (a)(4) in

2-1 an amount that does not exceed the lesser of 10 percent of the total
2-2 construction cost of the project or \$5 million.

2-3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
