1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to injury leave for certain peace officers.
1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-19 SECTION 1. Section [661.918](#)(a), Government Code, is amended
1-20 to read as follows:
1-21 (a) This section applies to a peace officer under Article
1-22 [2.12](#), Code of Criminal Procedure, who is commissioned as a law
1-23 enforcement officer or agent, including a ranger, by:
1-24 (1) the Public Safety Commission and the director of
1-25 the Department of Public Safety;
1-26 (2) the Parks and Wildlife Commission; ~~[or]~~
1-27 (3) the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission; or
1-28 (4) the attorney general.
1-29 SECTION 2. Section [661.918](#)(a), Government Code, as amended
1-30 by this Act, applies only to an injury that occurs on or after the
1-31 effective date of this Act.
1-32 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
