2 (b) If civil or criminal jurisdiction of a county court is 3 transferred to a district court, the clerk of the county court shall 4 send a certified copy of the judgments rendered in the county court 5 that remain unsatisfied, in electronic or paper form, to the 6 district clerks of the appropriate counties.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
