- 15 In addition to a report required by other state law or rule, the
- 16 judge of each court in this state that appointed an attorney ad
- 17 litem for a case before the court in the preceding state fiscal year
- 18 <u>shall prepare a report on:</u>
- 19 (1) the name of each attorney appointed by the court as
- 20 an attorney ad litem for a case in that year;
- 21 (2) the rate and total amount of compensation paid to
- 22 each attorney ad litem appointed by the court in that year; and
- 23 (3) the number of hours each attorney served as an
