S.B. No. 1373

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the authority of a county to adopt a fire code. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 233.061(a), Local Government Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (a) The commissioners court of a county [with a population 7 of over 250,000 or a county adjacent to a county with a population of over 250,000] may adopt a fire code and rules necessary to 8 administer and enforce the fire code. 9 SECTION 2. Sections 233.062(a) and (b), Local Government 10 11 Code, are amended to read as follows: 12 (a) The fire code applies only to the following buildings constructed in an unincorporated area of the county: 13 14 (1) an inhabitable [a] commercial establishment; a public building; and 15 (2) a multifamily residential dwelling consisting of 16 (3) four or more units. 17 18 The fire code: (b) (1) does not apply to: 19 20 (A) an industrial facility having a fire brigade 21 that conforms to requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health 22 [and Safety] Administration; or 23 (B) development on a tract of land appraised as 24 agricultural or open-space land by the appraisal district; and

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1 (2) may not be enforced in a manner that limits or 2 otherwise impairs the rights of individuals or entities in the 3 exploration, development, or production of oil, gas, or other 4 minerals.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
