## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT 2 relating to authorization by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board for certain public junior colleges to offer 3 baccalaureate degree programs. 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 130.0012, Education Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsections (k) and (1) to read as follows: 8

9 (a) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board may [shall] authorize public junior colleges to offer baccalaureate 10 degree programs in the fields of applied science, [and] applied 11 12 technology, and dental hygiene under this section. Offering a baccalaureate degree program under this section does not otherwise 13 alter the role and mission of a public junior college. 14

(b) The coordinating board shall authorize baccalaureate 15 16 degree programs at:

17 (1) each public junior college that previously participated in a pilot project to offer baccalaureate degree 18 programs; and 19

(2) one or more public junior colleges that offer a 20 degree program in the field of dental hygiene if, at the time the 21 degree is initially offered, the public junior college: 22

23 (A) has a main campus located in the county seat 24 of a county with a population greater than 200,000; and

1 (B) includes territory in at least six public 2 school districts located in two counties. 3 (k) The coordinating board shall adopt rules as necessary 4 for the administration of this section. 5 (1) In this section, "general academic teaching institution" and "institution of higher education" have the 6 7 meanings assigned by Section 61.003. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11

12 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
