- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 261.3022, Family Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:
- Sec. 261.3022. CHILD SAFETY CHECK ALERT LIST. (a) Subject 7
- to the availability of funds, the Department of Public Safety of the 8
- State of Texas shall create a child safety check alert list as part 9
- of the Texas Crime Information Center to help locate a child or the 10
- 11 child's family for purposes of:
- 12 (1) investigating a report of child abuse or neglect
- or conducting an alternative response as provided by Section 13
- 14 261.3015;
- 15 (2) providing protective services to a family
- 16 receiving in-home support services; or
- (3) providing protective services to the family of a 17
- child in the managing conservatorship of the department. 18
- If the child safety check alert list is established and 19 (b)
- the department is unable to locate a child's family for 20
- a purpose stated in Subsection (a) [purposes of investigating a 21
- report of child abuse or neglect], after the department has 22
- 23 exhausted all means available to the department for locating the
- child or the child's family, the department may seek assistance 24

- 1 under this section from the appropriate [county attorney, district
- 2 attorney, or criminal district] attorney with responsibility for
- 3 representing the department as provided by Section 264.009.
- 4 (c) If the department requests assistance, the county
- 5 attorney, district attorney, or criminal district attorney, as
- 6 applicable, may file an application with the court requesting the
- 7 issuance of an ex parte order requiring the Texas Crime Information
- 8 Center to place the child or the members of the child's family whom
- 9 the department is attempting to locate on a child safety check alert
- 10 list. The application must include a summary of:
- 11 (1) <u>either:</u>
- 12 (A) the report of child abuse or neglect the
- 13 department is attempting to investigate or for which the department
- 14 is attempting to conduct an alternative response; or
- 15 (B) the circumstances in a case described by
- 16 Subsection (a)(2) or (3) that cause a child to be at a substantial
- 17 risk of harm because the family cannot be located; and
- 18 (2) the department's efforts to locate the child or the
- 19 child's family.
- 20 (d) If the court determines after a hearing that the family
- 21 cannot be located to investigate or provide an alternative response
- 22 for a report of child abuse or neglect or that a child is at risk of
- 23 substantial harm because the family cannot be located and that the
- 24 department has exhausted all means available to the department for
- 25 locating the child or the child's family, as applicable, the court
- 26 shall approve the application and order the appropriate law
- 27 enforcement agency to notify the Texas Crime Information Center to

- 1 place the child or the child's family, as applicable, on a child
- 2 safety check alert list. The alert list must include:
- 3 (1) <u>if applicable</u>, the name of the family member
- 4 alleged to have abused or neglected a child according to the report
- 5 the department is attempting to investigate or for which the
- 6 department is attempting to conduct an alternative response;
- 7 (2) the name of any parent, managing conservator, or
- 8 guardian of the child who cannot be located for the purposes
- 9 described by Subsection (a);
- 10 (3) the name of the child who is the subject of the
- 11 report or an ongoing department case;
- 12 (4) if applicable, (3) a code identifying the type
- 13 of child abuse or neglect alleged or determined to have been
- 14 committed against the child;
- 15 (5) [(4)] the family's last known address; and
- 16 (6) (5) the minimum criteria for an entry as
- 17 established by the center.
- SECTION 2. Section 261.3023(a), Family Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (a) If a law enforcement officer encounters a person,
- 21 <u>including a child</u>, listed on the Texas Crime Information Center's
- 22 child safety check alert list [who is alleged to have abused or
- 23 neglected a child, or encounters a child listed on the alert list
- 24 who is the subject of a report of child abuse or neglect the
- 25 department is attempting to investigate], the officer shall request
- 26 information from the person or the child regarding the child's
- 27 well-being and current residence.

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- 1 SECTION 3. Section 261.3024(a), Family Code, is amended to 2 read as follows:
- 3 (a) A law enforcement officer who locates a child listed on
- 4 the Texas Crime Information Center's child safety check alert list
- 5 [who is the subject of a report of child abuse or neglect the
- 6 department is attempting to investigate] and who reports the
- 7 child's current address and other relevant information to the
- 8 department under Section 261.3023 shall report to the Texas Crime
- 9 Information Center that the child has been located.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
