- 5 SECTION 1. Section 61.9818, Education Code, is amended to

- 7 Sec. 61.9818. PROGRAM FUNDING. The program may be funded
- 8 [solely] from:
- 9 <u>(1)</u> gifts, grants, and donations solicited and
- 10 accepted by the board for the purposes of this subchapter; and
- 11 (2) fees collected under Chapter 401, Occupations
- 12 Code, in excess of the money required to pay the expenses for the
- 13 administration of that chapter.
- SECTION 2. Section 401.204, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 15 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- (c) Any money from fees collected by the board under this
- 17 chapter that remains after payment of the expenses for the
- 18 administration of this chapter may be used to fund the loan
- 19 repayment program established under Subchapter II, Chapter 61,
- 20 Education Code, as added by Chapter 133 (S.B. 620), Acts of the 83rd
- 21 Legislature, Regular Session, 2013.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
