1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the authority of certain municipalities to propose a
 1-18 fire control, prevention, and emergency medical services district.
 1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-20 SECTION 1. Section 344.051, Local Government Code, is
 1-21 amended by adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows:
 1-22 (a-2) The governing body of a municipality may propose the
 1-23 creation of a fire control, prevention, and emergency medical
 1-24 services district under this chapter if the municipality is located
 1-25 in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of another municipality that
 1-26 has a population of 200,000 or more, both of which are located in a
 1-27 county with a population of less than 300,000 that is located on the
 1-28 international border.
 1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
