- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 302.048, Labor Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsections (d-1) and
- 8 (g) to read as follows:
- 9 (c) Based on the criteria prescribed under this section, the
- 10 commission shall develop annual performance measures to be used by
- 11 the commission to evaluate each local workforce development board.
- 12 (d) The commission shall post on its Internet website an
- 13 <u>annual report of</u> the results of the commission's <u>most recent</u>
- 14 evaluation of each local workforce development board. The report
- 15 must be posted:
- 16 (1) not later than the end of the second quarter
- 17 following the 12-month period covered by the report, as determined
- 18 by the commission for purposes of this subdivision; and
- 19 (2) [on the commission's Internet website] in a format
- 20 that:
- 21 (A) is readily accessible to and understandable
- 22 by a member of the public; and
- 23 (B) includes any necessary explanatory
- 24 information.

- 1 (d-1) The annual report posted by the commission on its
- 2 Internet website under Subsection (d) must include the following
- 3 information regarding each local workforce development board:
- 4 (1) a comparison of the board's result on each annual
- 5 performance measure established by the commission with the
- 6 applicable commission-established target for that measure; and
- 7 (2) a summary of material findings from the most
- 8 recent financial monitoring review conducted by the commission.
- 9 (g) Each local workforce development board shall include in
- 10 a prominent location on its Internet website a link to the annual
- 11 report required to be posted on the commission's website under
- 12 <u>Subsection</u> (d).
- 13 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is
- 14 amended by adding Section 302.049 to read as follows:
- Sec. 302.049. JOB TRAINING PROGRAM DATABASE. (a) To
- 16 <u>facilitate a consumer's informed selection among job training</u>
- 17 programs, the commission shall:
- 18 (1) include in its searchable database of job training
- 19 programs that are currently approved by one or more local workforce
- 20 development boards and certified by the commission, annual
- 21 performance outcomes for each program, including the program's
- 22 completion rate, post-program completion entered employment rate,
- 23 and average starting hourly wages at placement, or, if hourly wages
- 24 are not appropriate, post-program completion average quarterly
- 25 wages; and
- 26 (2) update the database to reflect the most recent
- 27 annual performance outcomes of programs not later than the end of

- 1 the second quarter following the 12-month period for which outcomes
- 2 were computed, as determined by the commission for purposes of this
- 3 subdivision.
- 4 (b) Each local workforce development board and certified
- 5 provider of a job training program included in the database
- 6 described by Subsection (a) shall submit to the commission any data
- 7 requested by the commission regarding job training programs as
- 8 necessary for the commission to carry out its duties under that
- 9 subsection.
- 10 <u>(c) The commission may adopt rules as necessary to</u>
- 11 administer this section.
- 12 SECTION 3. The Texas Workforce Commission shall post on its
- 13 Internet website the first annual report required by Section
- 14 302.048(d), Labor Code, as amended by this Act, not later than May
- 15 1, 2016.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
