- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 401, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 401.103 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 401.103. VETERANS HEALTH ISSUES. (a) The governor or
- 8 the governor's designee may negotiate with the United States
- 9 Department of Veterans Affairs and any other appropriate federal
- 10 agency on matters relating to improving the delivery of health care
- 11 services to veterans in this state, including:
- 12 (1) establishing a veterans hospital in the Rio Grande
- 13 Valley region of the state; and
- 14 (2) ensuring the prompt payment of claims submitted by
- 15 community health care providers to the United States Department of
- 16 Veterans Affairs for health care services provided to veterans by
- 17 those providers.
- 18 (b) The governor, in consultation with the board of regents
- 19 of The University of Texas System, may identify shared resources
- 20 and collaborative opportunities that may be used by the School of
- 21 Medicine at The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley and the United
- 22 States Department of Veterans Affairs to provide quality health
- 23 care services to residents of the Rio Grande Valley.
- 24 <u>(c) The governor may request the assistance of the</u>

- 1 Department of State Health Services, the Health and Human Services
- 2 Commission, the Texas Veterans Commission, or any other state
- 3 agency, department, or office in performing an action under this
- 4 section. The agency, department, or office shall provide the
- 5 requested assistance.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 434.019(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The Texas Veterans Commission and the Department of
- 9 State Health Services, in collaboration with the office of the
- 10 governor, shall work with the United States Department of Veterans
- 11 Affairs and any other appropriate federal agency to propose that
- 12 the federal government establish a veterans hospital in the Rio
- 13 Grande Valley region of the state.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
